THE WEST ROOM

The Grand West Room (pictured) is bursting with original charm and elegant architecture, ideal for a function for 90 seated. It can also host 120 guests standing. The room comes complete with a sound system, 2 metre projector screen and free WiFi.

THE EAST ROOM

The lovingly restored East Room, with its refined, luxurious decor, is the perfect space for an intimate party, accommodating 50 people standing or 25 seated.

THE SIDE GARDEN

A large, leafy outside area at the side of the pub, that is well lit and partially covered with extra large parasols.

The Side Garden can host 75 standing and 25 seated.

THE PATIO

The patio is situated in our back garden, a lovely raised area with a mix of banquette seating and high tables which is covered and heated in the Winter. The Patio can host 50 people standing, or 30 seated.

THE ASTRO

Another area of our back garden, the Astro is next to the children's playground. This area can host 40 standing, or 20 seated and is covered in the Winter. Please note the children's playground cannot be booked.

Gardens are booked at your own risk with regards to bad weather on the day. We will try our best on the day to find you some space inside the pub but this cannot be guaranteed.

Music is not allowed in gardens and gardens must close at 10pm.

ROOM VIEWINGS

We are happy to let you have a look at our private rooms any time when we are open and the rooms are free. Unless prior arrangement has been made, we cannot guarantee being able to show you around.

If you wish to have a last minute look at our private rooms, the best thing to do is give us a call to check whether the rooms are free, if they are busy then we will be unable to let you view.

MEETINGS

The events manager holds meetings Monday-Wednesday evenings by appointment. These must be scheduled at least 10 days prior.

PLEASE NOTE: We do not hold meetings or tastings in December and on Bank Holidays.

VENUE

The private rooms are situated on the first floor, either side of a shared corridor. Access is via stairs located just next to the bar. There is another set of stairs leading to the West Room from the back garden which can be used as a separate entrance for entertainers to load in and out if required.

DISABLED ACCESS

Unfortunately the only access to the first floor is via stairs. The ground floor and gardens are accessible and there is a disabled toilet. Stair climbers can be used however we do not provide them. If you will be using a stair climber, please have a look at the stairwell dimensions below:

Main stairwell

Staircase width 75.5cm (small landing halfway up as the stairs turn 180° is 72cm wide). Individual stair height 20cm / Number of stairs 22

Rear stairwell

Staircase width 82cm / Individual stair height 18cm / Number of stairs 22

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YOUR QUESTION'S ANSWERED

CHILDREN

Children are more than welcome to attend functions at The Rosendale and we have a dedicated kid's menu. In the summer months there is kids play area in the back garden that can be used. Kids are allowed until 8pm in the pub usually (unless eating a meal like an adult) so we do ask for them to be closely supervised if downstairs after 8pm. As per our premises licence, children (under 16s) must be supervised by an adult at all times.

MISCELLANEOUS

The West Room is air conditioned.

There is a unisex toilet on the first floor with additional toilets located on the ground floor. Baby changing facilities are available on the ground floor.

MOBILE BAR

We have a mobile bar upstairs which can be used. It has draught beer and a condensed version of drinks that are available downstairs. Specific drinks we stock downstairs but not usually upstairs can be made available if requested in advance.

CORKAGE

If you would like to bring your own wine, we charge corkage of: £15 per 75cl bottle of still wine £20 per 75cl bottle of sparkling wine £25 per 75cl bottle of Champagne £4pp 'Cakage' (bringing your own cake for pudding to be served by us)

CATERING

We have our own in house catering team and unfortunately do not allow the use of outside caterers.

ROOM SETUP

We provide white linen tablecloths and napkins, glassware, cutlery and crockery. We have tealights and holders that can be used. We do not supply decorations but we are more than happy to decorate the rooms for you within reason.

TABLES

Round tables are 6ft diameter - maximum 10 seated Rectangular tables are 6ft x 2.5ft - maximum seated depends on configuration used.

YOUR QUESTION'S ANSWERED

ENTERTAINMENT

We are licensed for music (live and recorded). Live music must finish at 11pm after which only recorded music is allowed. The windows must remain closed during live performance and after 11pm. Bands, DJs, etc. must have vacated the premises by the same time as guests. As with live music, due to the close proximity of our neighbours, external sound systems can not be used after 11pm.

AUDIO VISUAL FACILITIES

Both private rooms have permanent sound systems with inputs for each located in the rooms. The sound systems are linked so the same music can be played in both rooms from one input. Alternatively different music can be played at the same time in each room. Inputs are via a 3.5mm jack lead (mini-jack or headphone) which we provide.

There is a permanent projector in the West Room with a 2m screen. Connection to the projector is via HDMI. A portable projector with smaller screen can be set up in the East Room upon request. We have a wireless microphone that can be used for speeches if required. Customers are to provide necessary converters to their devices.

ACCESS TO THE ROOMS

Access for suppliers and deliveries on the day is from 10am. As we have events most nights, we are unable to offer access for set up prior to the day. As we will be setting up from 10am, any suppliers (for example florists) who require the tables to be laid will need to speak to Events Manager in advance so a suitable time can be agreed.

DROPPING OFF & DELIVERIES

You can drop off items before the day that can be stored securely at The Rosendale. Please speak to the events manager about organising a suitable time. Deliveries to the pub on the day can be accepted from 10am. Please ask suppliers who need to deliver in advance to liaise with us so we can organise a suitable time when the pub is quieter.

PARKING

There is no car park at The Rosendale but all the surrounding roads are free to park all day every day.

The Terms & Conditions set out below shall be governed in accordance with the laws of England & Wales.

The Rosendale reserves the right to refuse entry to the venue or remove from the premises any person whose behaviour or demeanour is not conducive to the enjoyment and safety of other customers and staff

The Client will be held responsible for and will recompense the Rosendale for any damage caused to our goods or premises by their guests.

Abusive behaviour towards members of our staff or other customers will not be tolerated and will be reported to the police. Drugs and drug taking is not tolerated on the premises. Anyone Gardens caught doing so will be reported to the police.

RESERVATIONS, DEPOSIT & CANCELLATIONS

A deposit of £200 is required. By paying your deposit, you agree to these Terms & Conditions. All bookings are provisional until the Rosendale have received cleared deposit funds.

Deposits can be paid by bank transfer or by credit/debit card. Cheques are not accepted.

The deposit is refundable if cancelled 14 days prior to the event. The deposit is non-refundable following this 14 day cancellation window.

Provisional bookings will be held for 14 days without confirmation/ deposit after that time they will be cancelled.

SERVICE CHARGE

A service charge of 12.5% will be added to the final bill which is mandatory. All of which is distributed in full to all our staff. Service charge is not included in minimum spends.

CORKAGE

Wine, Prosecco & Champagne may be brought into and consumed on the premises with prior permission from the management and will be subject to the following corkage charges:

Wine - £15 per bottle

Prosecco/Sparkling wine - £20 a bottle

Champagne - £25 a bottle

No other alcohol, drinks or food may be brought into or consumed on the premises.

All beverages must be purchased on the premises and any external beverages brought into the venue will be confiscated commotion, malicious damage, compliance with any law or and returned at the end of the event.

CAKE CHARGES

There is no additional charge for a cake as part of the evening food or buffet. There is a charge of £4 per person + 12.5% service charge to serve a cake as a dessert or as part of a meal with plates and cutlery.

During live performance all windows must remain closed and must stop by 11pm as per our Premises license. After 11pm all windows must remain closed for recorded music. No music is allowed in our gardens.

The side garden and back closes at 10pm every day.

ORDER CONFIRMATION

Food orders must be received by email 14 days prior to your event or we cannot guarantee food or drinks choices. The final number of guests is required 14 days before the event, if numbers decrease following that you will still be charged for all items ordered.

FINAL NUMBERS

Final Numbers must be confirmed at least 14 days prior to the event. If numbers decrease from the confirmed numbers, after payment of the confirmed amount, no reduction or refund will be issued.

The Pub may be able to accommodate an increase of numbers. This will be subject to the availability of produce and at the discretion of the General Manager.

PAYMENT TERMS

Full & final settlement of the bill will be required in the week leading up to your event date. All major credit and debit cards are accepted and payments can be made via bank transfers. Cheques are not accepted.

FORCE MAJEURE

The Pub and it's management shall have no liability to the Client under the Agreement if it is prevented from or delayed in performing its obligations under the Agreement or from carrying on its business by acts, events, omissions or accidents beyond its reasonable control, including strikes, lock-outs or other industrial disputes (whether involving the workforce of The Pub or any other party), failure of a utility service or transport network, act of God, war, acts of terrorism, riot, civil governmental order, rule, regulation or direction, accident, breakdown of plant or machinery, fire, flood, storm.

If any other means of attaching decorations to ceiling or walls is discovered by management a £200 redecoration fee will be charged to the lead booker.

Any printed emblem, sign or image that the management find inappropriate will be taken down.

The Managers decision is final.

STORAGE

The Pub and it's management shall have no liability to the Client to store any belongings, decoration or other items for more than 24 hours. After which such items will need to be collected with prior arrangement with the management.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESS

Unfortunately the only access to the first floor is via stairs. The ground floor and gardens are accessible and there is a disabled toilet. Stair climbers can be used however we do not provide them. If you will be using a stair climber, please see 'your questions answered' for the stairwell dimensions.
